The headlines for such a sheet may be: Words I know, words I've seen but don't really know; New words. Students can list the vocabulary of the word and the likely meanings under the headlines. As the lesson continues, they can make changes and additions. Each page in each three-person lesson uses all ten dictionary words. Exercises on most pages use each vocabulary word once. Encourage students to think of the best word to complete a sentence or answer every question. Some words have more than one meaning, including some not given in the lesson.
